Transportation Community Forum

The University of Wyoming will host a community forum Wednesday, Jan. 16, to gather input for a Transportation and Parking Master Plan. The forum is from 5-7 p.m. at the Laramie Recreation Center, 920 Boulder Dr., off Grand Avenue. The primary purpose of the master plan study is to analyze various elements related to mobility, transit and parking demands on and around the UW campus and to provide recommendations for future improvement.
